

Para configurar el IPHONE para tu cuenta de correo sigue los pasos que a continuación se presentan:

1. From the Dashboard, click **Settings**.



2. Under **Settings**, select **Mail, Contacts, Calendars**.



3. Select **Add Account...**



4. Select **Other** as the type of account.



5. Enter the requested information:

- **Name:** the name of the mail user
- **Address:** the email address of the mail user
- **Password:** enter the users password (incoming mail server and external mail server)
- **Description:** a description of the mail user
